“The Voice” was founded by 6 students in 2000. “The Voice” is a non-political, non-governmental and non-profit-making organization. Its motto is: “To help those, who are not able to help themselves”.

These students were moved and overwhelmed by the disabilities and miseries of handicapped children and orphans and they decided to help them through their own small income, which they received from their part time jobs.

In the meantime they have become part of the educated class in their country and are now able to continue their support more broadly with the help of friends and like-minded people.

Currently about 145 children are receiving regular help, i.e. disabled children, orphans and street children. They are provided with the basic necessities, but they can also benefit from the education and health programmes, which are supplied by the “Voice”.

The organisation also works for the Rights of Women, offering them free access to legal assistance.

Moreover “The Voice” also helps Brick kiln bonded labourers in general by freeing them from their bondage and offering them other possibilities, or connecting them with people who can support them through Micro-business financing.

Furthermore they try to help persecuted Christians in need; representing them in court and sometimes providing them with shelter.

Members of the “The Voice” are committed to people in need and take action, they look closely and help. Their great social commitment is outstanding and deserves the highest respect. Their example shows that compassion is the basis of initiating reconciliation processes and changing society in a positive way, thus realizing the vision of a fairer and more peaceful world.
