"Earth is Our Common Home" - Siberia/ Russia

The Siberian Centre of Eurasian Projects has been working for 13 years in Russia, Eurasia and all over the world. It is about to establish a network of international youth villages where young people from all over the world can meet and learn to live together, collectively creating visions of the future and setting up an action plan to make these visions come true.

In summer 2009, the year of the UN International Reconciliation Year, the organization realized the "Earth is our Common Home" project in carrying out various events, dealing with reconciliation between human beings as well as between man and nature. They took place at different healing places, for example in Altai, at the Baikal Lake, Sayan Mountains and Issyk Kul Lake, Kazakhstan and Kyrgyzstan. Here people met from Eurasia and from all over the world to learn to live together in harmony and creating joint projects through life art design and theatre programmes based on the idea of unity in diversity.

The central concern of this project is to let the participants be given the experience that it is possible not only to live together peacefully and with respect for Mother Nature, to love and cherish it but also to heal the nature and the world by conscious collective presence and humane feelings.

These initiatives will be continued this year and in future, aiming at a new consciousness and creating a new understanding, enabling a raise in human dignity with the goal of peace for all human beings and harmony with mother earth.
